Hobby Horsing is an activity in which participants "ride" on hobby horses and overcome various exercises and obstacles. Materials: Hobbies: wood, plastic, fabric (for the horse's head), filling material (polyester fibre) Accessories: Headbands, saddle pads, nosebands made of fabric, leather or plastic Dangers: Mechanical hazard: Improper use or damaged accessories can lead to injury. Choking hazard: Small parts such as buttons or loose components can be swallowed, which is especially dangerous for young children. Chemical hazard: Some materials may contain chemicals that are harmful to health and can cause skin irritation or allergic reactions. Risk of falling: There is a risk of falling when jumping or running with the hobby horse, especially on uneven terrain. Safety Measures: Handling: Use the products only according to the manufacturer's instructions. Inspection: Regularly inspect the hobby horses and accessories for wear or damage and replace defective parts immediately. Storage: Store products in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Cleaning: Follow the manufacturer's care instructions to keep the products clean and in good condition.
